

ACC commissions 2.5-MW wind farm

Mumbai, April 9

ACC has commissioned a 2.5-MW wind energy farm near Satara, Maharashtra, at a cost of Rs 13 crore. The wind farm has two 1.5-MW turbines. The power from the wind farm will be supplied through a wheeling arrangement to ACC's Thane Complex and Bulk Cement Corporation (India), a subsidiary of ACC at Kalamboli, near Mumbai. ACC said that the power generated would be sufficient to address 70 per cent of its Thane Complex requirement and 64 per cent of the Kalamboli unit. ACC now has a total wind power capacity of 19 MW of which nine MW is in Tamil Nadu, 7.5 MW in Rajasthan and 2.5 MW in Maharashtra. — **Our Bureau**
